



Casual/dress slacks are required. Pants are to be worn at the waist

Two-kick pleat, pleat kilt, and split skirt styles are approved. We strongly suggest that girls wear shorts under their skirts if they are not wearing tights.

If a student is unable to adhere to dress code he/she will be sent home.



Black, navy, or brown belts must be worn at all times.



Girls in Grades 1 - 4 may wear jumpers in any style of skirt with the same length requirements for skirts.

Uniform shorts are acceptable for Grades 1-4 during certain seasons. Shorts should resemble dress code pants in style and color. Shorts must not have exterior pockets. Acceptable colors are black, navy, or khaki.

CCA is recommending students use gaiters rather than face masks. Dress code colors apply to both.



Socks, leggings, and hosiery must be appropriate solid colors. They also must be worn everyday.

ACCEPTABLE COLORS ARE SOLID ONLY!

Students must wear dress shoes for normal school days

Only black, brown, or navy dress shoes are permitted; topsider (Sperry) style shoes are acceptable. Slip-on dress shoes are required in grades 1-3.

A Special Note to Parents:

Cornerstone Christian Academy students are a reflection of both the Lord Jesus Christ and the Academy, Neatness, modesty, and cleanliness are core attributes promoted by the dress code.

On Dress Down Days, students can wear modest jeans or loose fitting warm-up pants.

On Mondays, students may wear their own CCA sports jackets over an in-code shirt, but no hoodies are acceptable.

On Fridays, students may wear Patriot shirts, CCA hoodies or crew necks, and CCA Mission shirts. IN SEASON JV/V athletes may wear their full warm-ups and CCA jackets -- no tight joggers.

Any shoes may be worn, EXCEPT slides and sandals.
