

# CCA Elementary Summer Reading

- All elementary students are encouraged to read chapters from the book of **Psalms** over the summer.
- In addition, please complete the following assignment for the class you are about to enter. All projects will be shared on the first day of school.

## K5

Books: read books about animals; record list of all books read

Project: choose one animal from books and make a poster board presentation

Include: drawing or model of animal; habitat; food; and 5 interesting facts

## 1st

Complete 3 rows ( across, down or diagonally) on the Summer Reading Bingo sheet and list all books read on the back.

Project: Choose one book you read. Create a poster sharing the title, author, main character, a short summary and a picture of your favorite part.

## 2nd

Choose a fictional chapter book to read:

Fill out the given Book Report worksheet and complete one of the following projects:

- 1) Create a poster board sharing the title, main character, a short summary and one favorite part.
- 2) Make a shoebox diorama describing the main character
- 3) Write a letter to a friend telling them why they should read the book
- 4) Dress up as the main character and present your Book Report worksheet

## 3rd

Read *The Lemonade War* by Jacqueline Davies or *Cricket in Times Square* by George Selden

Project: Read the book and write a summary. Students also choose one of the following:

1. Have a lemonade stand and type a one page summary about the experience
2. Make a shoebox diorama of a situation from the book
3. Create a posterboard of a scene of your choice from the book

## 4th

READ: Choose one of these books to read: *The Tiger Rising* by Kate DiCamillo, *Shiloh* by Phylis Reynolds or the *Courage of Sarah Noble* by Alice Dalgliesh.

PROJECT: Students read a book and write a summary. Then, they decorate a paper grocery bag with a scene from the book, place five items that represent something from the book inside the bag, and present the bag to the class!
