

CCA Elementary Summer Reading 2023

Please complete the following assignment for the class you are about to enter. All projects will be shared on the first day of school.

K5

Read: Read books about animals; record a list of all books read

Project: choose one animal and make a poster board presentation

Include: drawing or model of animal; habitat; food; and 5 interesting facts

1st grade

Read: Complete 3 rows (across, down or diagonally) on the Summer Reading Bingo sheet and list all books read on the back.

Project: Choose one book you read. Create a poster sharing the title, author, main character, a short summary and a picture of your favorite part.

2nd grade

Read: Choose a fictional chapter book to read:

Project: Fill out the **Book Report** worksheet and complete one of the following:

- 1) Create a poster board sharing the title, main character, a short summary and one favorite part.
- 2) Make a shoebox diorama describing the main character
- 3) Write a letter to a friend telling them why they should read the book

3rd grade

Read: Choose one book from the Boxcar Children series by Gertrude Chandler Warner.

Project: Create a poster board that includes the title, author, main character(s), a summary of the book, and a rating out of 5 stars/would you recommend it to a friend.

4th grade

Read: *Read Tales of 4th Grade Nothing* by Judy Blume

(This book will be provided on the last week of school and should be returned on the first day of school.)

Project: Write a summary. Decorate a paper grocery bag with a scene from the book, place five items that represent something from the book inside the bag, and present the bag to the class!

All elementary students are encouraged to read the book of John over the summer.
