

Elementary AfterCARE

What is AfterCARE?

Elementary AfterCARE is a service provided by CCA in which students can remain in school after the school day concludes until parents can pick them up, but not later than 5:30 pm.

What are the hours of operation for AfterCARE?

AfterCARE runs from **3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.** each school day.

How much does AfterCARE cost?

\$2.50/15 minute segment or portion thereof between 3:15-5:30.

Any parent picking up a student after 5:30 will be charged \$1 per minute per child.

What do students do at AfterCARE?

Elementary students will follow one of two schedules at AfterCARE depending on the weather. An INDOOR schedule will be used when there is inclement weather and students are not able to go outdoors. An OUTDOOR schedule will be used when weather permits. Both schedules include movement time, time to play in table seats, and a calm quiet activity.

What are the rules students are expected to follow at AfterCARE?

At AfterCARE, we C.A.R.E. C -cultivate kindness. A- Act with integrity. R- respect for each other, staff, and things. E- exhibit self control.

Students in aftercare are expected to uphold these standards and behave in a manner conducive to building community.

Students are expected to remain in uniform through the duration of AfterCARE and are not permitted to use cell phones during AfterCARE.

Where do I pick up my student from AfterCARE?

When students are **indoors**, AfterCARE pickup for elementary students occurs at **DOOR F**. When picking up, pull up to the awning at Door F and an AfterCARE staff member will bring your student to you.

When students are **outdoors**, AfterCARE pickup for elementary students occurs at **the edge of the playground**. When picking up, pull up to the barrier facing Rt. 91 and an AfterCARE staff member will bring your student to you. Aftercare staff will note the time of pick-up when you pull up to pick up your student. .

Under NO circumstances is a pick-up person permitted to enter the school building or playground area or remove a child from the Aftercare line. This is a safety precaution for students, staff, and families alike.

Persons picking up from AfterCARE should be on a student's pick-up list in RENweb and may be asked to present a valid ID to verify their identity.
