

# Summer AR Instructions

## STEP 1- Choosing a book

- When choosing a book to read for AR, look for books that fall within your child's reading range (ZPD).
- To determine if a book is in the correct range, go to AR book find and type in the title.
- AR Book Find.com can be accessed on Summer AR Google Classroom or it can be googled for easy use on your phone. This allows you to check books on the go from any place.
- When the book comes up it will tell you what book level(BL) it is and how many AR points it counts for. If the book level falls within your child's ZPD/ BL range, this is a good choice for your child. (You want the book level to fall within your child's ZPD.)
- Students should then read a copy of their chosen book. AR does not provide books, just quizzes.

## STEP 2- Taking a quiz

- After reading the entire book, go to the Summer AR Google Classroom. You can only access your AR account through the unique school AR link located on the Summer AR Google Classroom or the link at the bottom of this page.
- Students should log in to their AR account to take their quiz using their username and password listed below. Follow the prompts to enter the title of the book.
- After completing the quiz, your child will receive AR points based on how many correct answers they received on the quiz.
- If a student fails the quiz, they do not receive AR points.
- **Reading carefully is important.**

## Completion Deadline

AR summer reading must be completed by **July 26**. After this we will be updating the system for the new school year.

Rising 3rd graders are required to complete 6 AR points; rising 4th graders are required to complete 8 AR points.

Students can track their reading progress by watching the Reading Rocket at the end of each quiz.
