



SUMMER MATH REQUIREMENT: Students entering Grade 5

At the close of the school year, your child will bring home a summer math packet. In order to keep your child's math skills sharp over the summer, **students are required to complete this packet**. Points earned from the packet will be entered as a grade for the first 9 weeks of the new school year. **The completed packet should be brought to school no later than Friday, August 16, 2024.**

Copies for new students enrolling at CCA will be available in the office after June 1, 2024. The packet will also be available in Google Classroom beginning Tuesday, May 28.

These programs are designed to review the previous years' skills and will help prepare students for the upcoming school year.
